Today at 4:00 is the men's monthly meeting to discuss the different works of the church. When I think of the opportunity this affords all the men of the congregation, my mind goes to the passage in Acts 14: 26-27, "From Attalia they (Paul and Barnabas) sailed back to Antioch, where they have been committed to the grace of God for the work they had now completed. On arriving there, they gathered the church together and reported all that God had done through them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles." The church at Antioch sent these men to preach the gospel to the Gentile world. Much money and much planning was expended by the whole church. When Paul and Barnabas returned, the whole church gathered to hear what God had worked through these two men. The reason the whole church gathered was because they were interested and personally involved in sending these two men.

We should have the same attitude as the early church. When the work of the church is being discussed, all of the men should have a desire to gather to be a part of the work. The work of the church is for all men to be involved in and comment on. The elders have provided the monthly men's meeting as a wonderful forum for the men of Suncoast to give input into the work and direction of the church. It's important that all the men be gathered together to do this: not just deacons or elders. If you are one of the men of the Suncoast family, take the time today to be an integral part of the planning of the works of this congregation of the Lord's church. 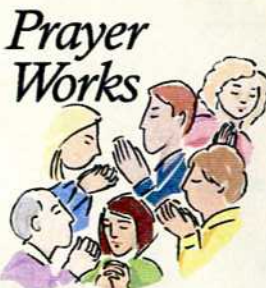
